2023 Highlights: Supporting movement, concretizing methodological learnings and strengthening infrastructure

- **Year 2 of Daily Practice Space:** 250 days of 30 minutes of free politicized somatics practice every weekday morning for movement leaders and alumni. Register here!
  - We remain committed to a BIPOC majority space
  - o Over a 100 new people sign up every month
  - o 30-40 largely BIPOC organizers and leaders held daily by a gs practitioner
  - 100% of daily practice participants surveyed rate daily practice space as very helpful to their life

"I feel aware of the impact of being led through practice by a practitioner – in a collective. It's like the whole is greater than the sum of it's parts – ..... Otherwise, I find myself hardening, stiffening, and numbing. The practice keeps me in touch with my – and all– humanity in times of tremendous grief and collapse" – Josie

- Year 2 of Cultivating 8 BIPOC supervisors to diversify and widen leadership in the field of politicized somatics
  - BIPOC practitioners met monthly with a supervisor to develop and practice somatic supervision skills
  - 75 hours of investment to develop new BIPOC supervisors
- **Movement Partnerships** with Women on the Rise (WotR), Asian Pacific Environmental Network (APEN), investing almost 400 hours
  - Women on the Rise staff were supported by gs' first all-Black teaching team
  - Long-term ongoing relationship with APEN to support movement leaders
- Over 150 free 1:1 healing sessions organized by the gs Practitioner Network for organizers and healers actively organizing for the liberation of Palestine



 Over 1,100 people engaged with a <u>public</u> <u>webinar</u> on the beauty and possibility of politicized somatics in times of crisis in June 2023

- Protocol and training for gs practitioners on bringing politicized somatics to
  movement organizations through a skills-share of lessons learned, best practices, and
  innovations to align the offer of somatics to frontline organizations
- Updated course curriculum for this political and societal moment, including connecting to pleasure, land, spirit and centering disability justice
- Supporting gs' community of 80+ practitioners to continue to make free or low cost offers, including increasing offers to meet the needs of this political moment as more people are taking action on the streets

## 2024 Highlights: Accessible Offers and Wisdom Transfer

- Year 3 of Online Daily Practice Space:
  - In Fall 2023, practice space centered solidarity with Palestinian liberation
  - o In 2024, we will continue to evolve the practice space to support the political moment
- Launch Regional In-Person Practice Groups: Oakland, Los Angeles, Durham:
  - The spaces will be led by gs Practitioners for organizers, cultural and care workers
  - Monthly in-person, politically relevant practice space to meet the needs of organizers in a high-pressure election year

- Free 1:1 healing sessions and weekly healing groups to support and resource organizers and healers
- Lead Teachership Training for gs Practitioner Community:
  - 176 hour investment over six months to develop skills to lead teach a course
  - Wisdom transfer from three senior gs teachers to eight gs practitioners
- Protocol and training for gs practitioners on Healing Groups:
  - Skills-share for lessons learned, best practices and innovations
- Monthly gs Practitioner Network community calls:
  - o Organizing, building and planning for community led initiatives
  - Expanding leadership through collaboration between gs Practitioner community members
- Create a Lessons Learned document from the last 15 years of gs
  - Offer lessons from community and organization building at gs for internal learning and public sharing
